2020 in Review

The financial realities of the past year created challenges as funding mechanisms decreased and programming pivoted to a primarily virtual environment. Despite these challenges, we...



conducted 28 design assistance projects across the city with 70 volunteers and mOb studio students.



launched a design and entrepreneurial skills program for youth in the Northside.



organized community engagement initiatives in 5 neighborhoods.



designed a COVID-19 response and resource manual with our Six Points Innovation Center (6PIC) partners.



provided ongoing support to youth and families in the Highland Park neighborhood.



redesigned the 6PIC space into a virtual classroom for up to 15 students.

YOUTH INNOVATION STUDIO

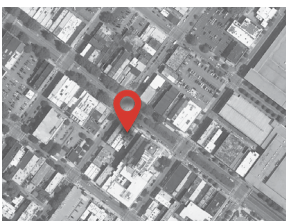
1. enhancing current youth programming to focus on project-based learning opportunities.
2. designing pilot projects that introduce new tracks for programming: *Foundations of Design and Entrepreneurship Innovation*.
3. including the culturally responsive healing model in program development.

DESIGN SESSION STUDIO

1. expanding design and planning assistance projects across all Richmond Voter Districts.
2. enhancing new program processes and outreach to increase impact in Richmond communities.
3. sharing resources developed in past and future design and planning projects.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT STUDIO

1. creating a community engagement process that supports community voice and builds a shared vision.
2. convening a participatory budgeting initiative that allows residents to guide where their tax dollars will go.
3. providing opportunities for community capacity training.
