A plan drawing is a two-dimensional drawing that shows the design/organization of a space or place from above. Think of a bird flying over a location, or how things look like from an airplane window. Plan drawings show similar elements as an aerial image.

Question... Can you determine the location of this plan drawing?



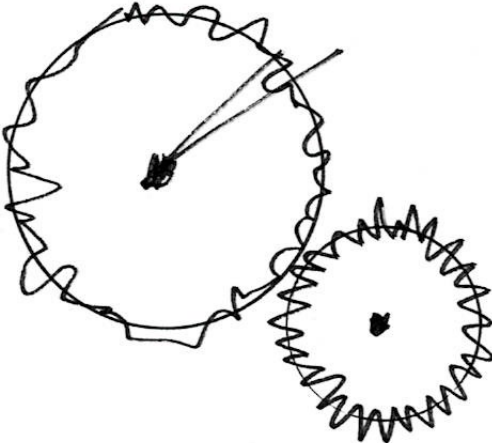
